



Mar Theodosius studied at Baselious College, Kottayam and Mar Thoma College, Thiruvalla. After receiving an undergraduate degree in science, he joined Leonard Theological College in Jabalpur and earned a B.D. Degree in 1972.

Thirumeni was ordained as Deacon on June 24, 1972.

He earned an M.A. and Ph.D. from McMaster University, Hamilton, Canada. He was consecrated as Episcopa on December 9, 1989. On November 14, 2020, Thirumeni was installed as the  $22^{nd}$  Mar Thoma Metropolitan with the title Theodosius Mar Thoma Metropolitan.

All designs were created by YF members!


