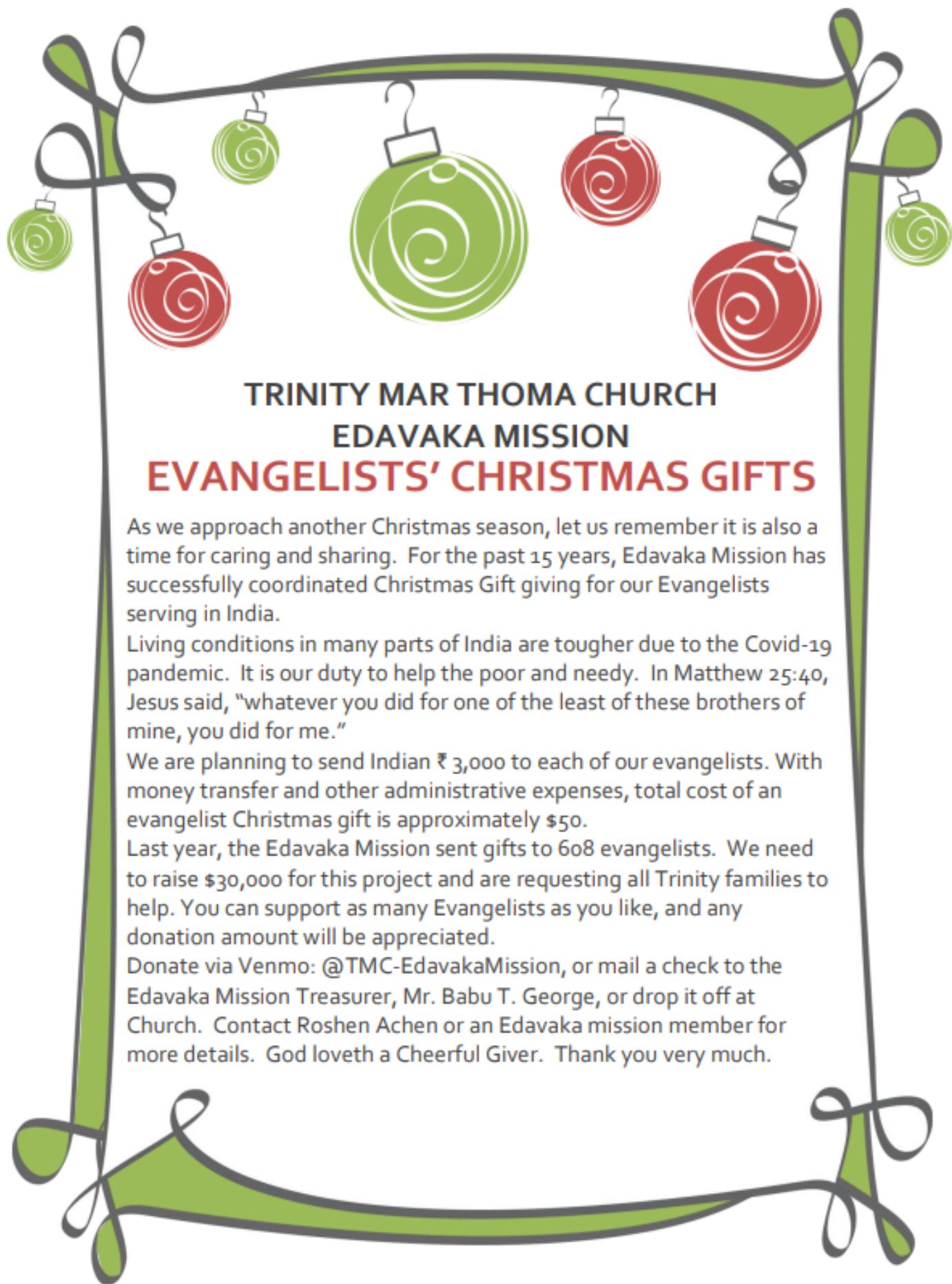

EVANGELISTS' CHRISTMAS GIFTS**

As we approach another Christmas season, let us remember it is also a time for caring and sharing. For the past 15 years, Edavaka Mission has successfully coordinated Christmas Gift giving for our Evangelists serving in India.

Living conditions in many parts of India are tougher due to the Covid-19 pandemic. It is our duty to help the poor and needy. In Matthew 25:40, Jesus said, "whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me."

We are planning to send Indian ₹ 3,000 to each of our evangelists. With money transfer and other administrative expenses, total cost of an evangelist Christmas gift is approximately \$50.

Our **Edavaka Mission Convention** was a blessing with three excellent speakers - Rev. David Cherian, Rev. Shoji Varghese, and Evangelist Cherry George Cherian. Thank you Roshen Achen, Mr. Abraham K. Idiculla, the Edavaka Mission Team, Choir, AV Ministry, for organizing an effective Convention.

I am looking forward to the in-person **Trinity English Convention**, led by Rev. Larry Varghese, scheduled from Thursday, October 8th through Sunday, October 10th. The talks will also be livestreamed. Attend this convention focused on the theme **Kingdom Building Through Families**.

The **Trinity campus building project**, estimated to cost \$3.6 million, slowly moved through the evaluation, planning, and estimating phases. In July 2021, the General Body and our Diocesan Bishop approved the project with a condition: raise 60% of the project cost - \$2.2 million, prior to construction.

In addition to requesting assistance from all Trinity Families, the Executive Committee has approved promotion of the project through classroom sponsorships (\$50k paid over multiple years) and donor recognition in four categories - \$25k, \$20k, \$15k and \$10k. **Please pray for and financially support the Trinity campus building project.**

### LIGHT TO LIFE MISSION PROJECT

*'Reaching Out to the Unreached with the Message of Love Through Education'*



#### Origin:

Light to Life is an initiative of the Mar Thoma Mission Board of the Diocese of North America and Europe that supports the education and holistic development of less privileged children in different parts of India. The project was officially launched in October 2017.

#### Vision:

Light to Life aims at social transformation through holistic development of children. Holding up the motto of the Mar Thoma Church, *Lighted to Lighten*, the mission intends to shed light in the lives of children to equip them to transform their own communities and the world at large.



#### Background /Need:

Even amidst the availability of educational institutions, the socio-economic situation in the remote villages of India prevents children from making use of such facilities. The lack of proper guidance, educational support, proper nutritious food, and fair clothing results in the discontinuing of studies. This is where the Light to Life project gets involved.



#### Project Design:

The project is designed to support education, to provide nutritious food and sufficient clothing, and to create a congenial environment for the emotional, social, and spiritual growth for less privileged children. The Mission Board has implemented this project in partnership with church-related agencies in different states of India. At present we are supporting 3,529 children through the following mission partners of the Mar Thoma Church: Christian Agency for Rural Development (CARD), South Travancore Agency for Rural Development (STARD), Mar Thoma Evangelistic Association (MTEA), Ranni-Nilackal Diocese, Chennai-Bangalore Diocese, Kottayam-Kochi Diocese, and Adoor Diocese. Holistic Child Development India (HCDI), based in Pune, is the monitoring agency for all our Light to Life projects. HCDI monitors the activities of each project and ensures that the finances are properly utilized.
