  - Covid Guidelines: See below suggested guidelines. We'll make additional changes on as-needed basis. All students, teachers and parents are requested to follow them, so that our children and church family can be safe and mitigate the spread of Covid virus.
    - 1) Sunday school starts at 10:30 am on Malayalam service Sundays and after the service on English service Sundays.
    - 2) No General sessions before classes.
    - 3) Students and teachers go directly to classes
    - 4) Head start to 2nd grade will be in Sunday school
    - 5) 3rd grade and above will be at Trinity Center
    - 6) Parents are requested to not to gather in Sunday school during classes. Only exception is for a parent of a head start child.
    - 7) Masks must be always worn during Sunday school
    - 8) Wipes and sanitizers will be placed at both Sunday School Hall and Trinity Center
    - 9) Teachers are requested to wipe desks if using them.
    - 10) Encourage students to use sanitizers and wash hands often.
    - 11) Seat the students appropriately distanced as well.
    - 12) After the dismissal from classes, students are encouraged to go to Divine service or home with their parents.
    - 13) Students are not allowed to hang around Sunday School Hall or Trinity center after their classes are done.
    - 14) If students or teachers are ill or have similar symptoms of covid, please stay home.

- The Ayathil Jerusalem Mar Thoma Church was founded in 1973 and the Church building was constructed in 1977. The building is structurally not sound and needs to be reconstructed. The 20 families attending this Parish are mostly day laborers and have requested our help to rebuild the Church (total cost: ~\$49k).
