We arranged Christmas get-togethers for all prayer groups. Our Organizations are coming together to celebrate Christmas on Dec 19<sup>th</sup> evening. We will be having our Christmas Play & Christmas Carol Service on Dec 24<sup>th</sup>. We are arranging English Holy Qurbana on Dec 25<sup>th</sup> and Malayalam Holy Qurbana on Dec 26<sup>th</sup>. Our Edavaka Mission is sending Christmas gifts to more than 600 evangelists. A team of members from Trinity MTC, Immanuel MTC & St. Thomas MTC, under the leadership of Rev. Sonu Varghese, is visiting the Mexico Mission to share Christmas gifts. I extend my thanks to Sunday School and the Church Executive Committee for contributing towards Christmas gifts.

We are moving forward toward achieving the goal of collecting \$1 million as contributions and pledges for Phase 1 collection of our Church Campus Expansion Project. I believe that we will be able to raise 60% of the project estimate by mid-2022 and start the construction by July, following approval from the General Body. Hello Everyone,

December is an exciting time to celebrate and reflect on the birth of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. For most companies and workplaces, December means end of the year performance reviews and planning for the new year. Plans created and goals set are reviewed and tagged with a dose of reality. Did it all get done?

Our life as Christ followers also deserves an occasional review.

Romans 12 reminds us of our responsibilities: (1) we are called to serve God with our different gifts - serving, teaching, encouraging, giving, leading & being merciful, (2) we are to live a life of Goodness, and (3) we are to live a life of graciousness. 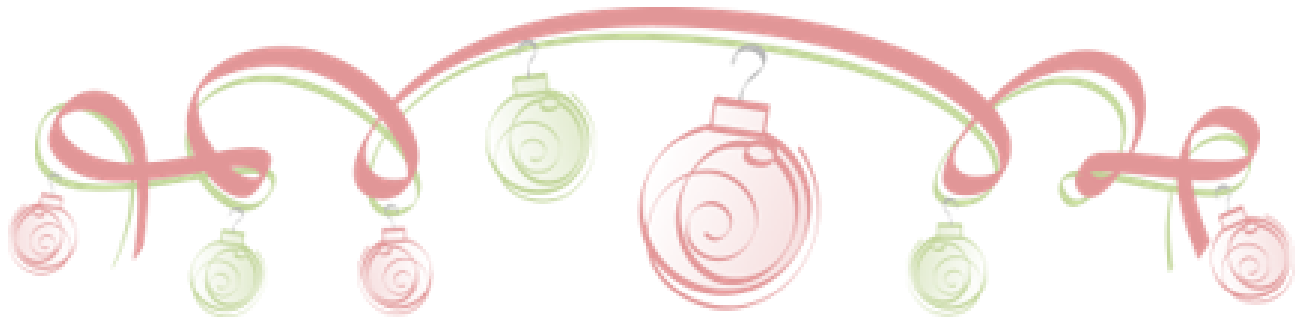
Our Parish continues to be touched by the presence of our Heavenly Father:

- Fifty-three of our children received their first Communion last month.
- Money raised from the Harvest Festival continues to make a difference in many people's lives. Funds raised from the Harvest Festival fundraising has helped with the construction of 3 homes in Kerala. In addition, 19 nursing students in India will receive annual educational assistance. Trinity also helped [\*Families Helping Families\*](#) provide 3,000 Houston Area families with 1 week of groceries, including a Thanksgiving meal.
- Trinity Mar Thoma Church was recognized for helping St. Johns Mar Thoma Church, Vechoochira (in Kerala) with their Church building project.
- Trinity members are providing valuable help with the re-building of the Ayathil Jerusalem Mar Thoma Church in Kerala.
- Fundraising for the Trinity MTC Campus Building Project, estimated to cost \$3.6 million, was blessed and kicked off by our Diocesan Bishop, Rt. Rev. Dr. Isaac Mar Philoxenos. Please continue to pray for and financially support this project. For more details, review presentation slides appended to this newsletter and the building project [website](#).

I appreciate the various encouraging efforts of all our multi-talented Church Organizations this year. Healing Hearts Ministry published an eBook titled [\*Yes, He Touched Me\*](#). Our Edavaka Mission is once again organizing the big effort to send a Christmas gift to every Mar Thoma missionary serving in India. Youth Fellowship, Young Family Fellowship, and Sunday School continue to lead our local ministry engagement. Senior Fellowship, Middle-Aged Family Fellowship, Sevika Sanghom, Yuvajana Sakhyam, AV Ministry, Malayalam & English Choirs and the Divine Worship Team continue to bless our Parish with their many engagements.

Please continue to pray for our Church, our Aghens and their families, the office bearers, executive committee, and me.

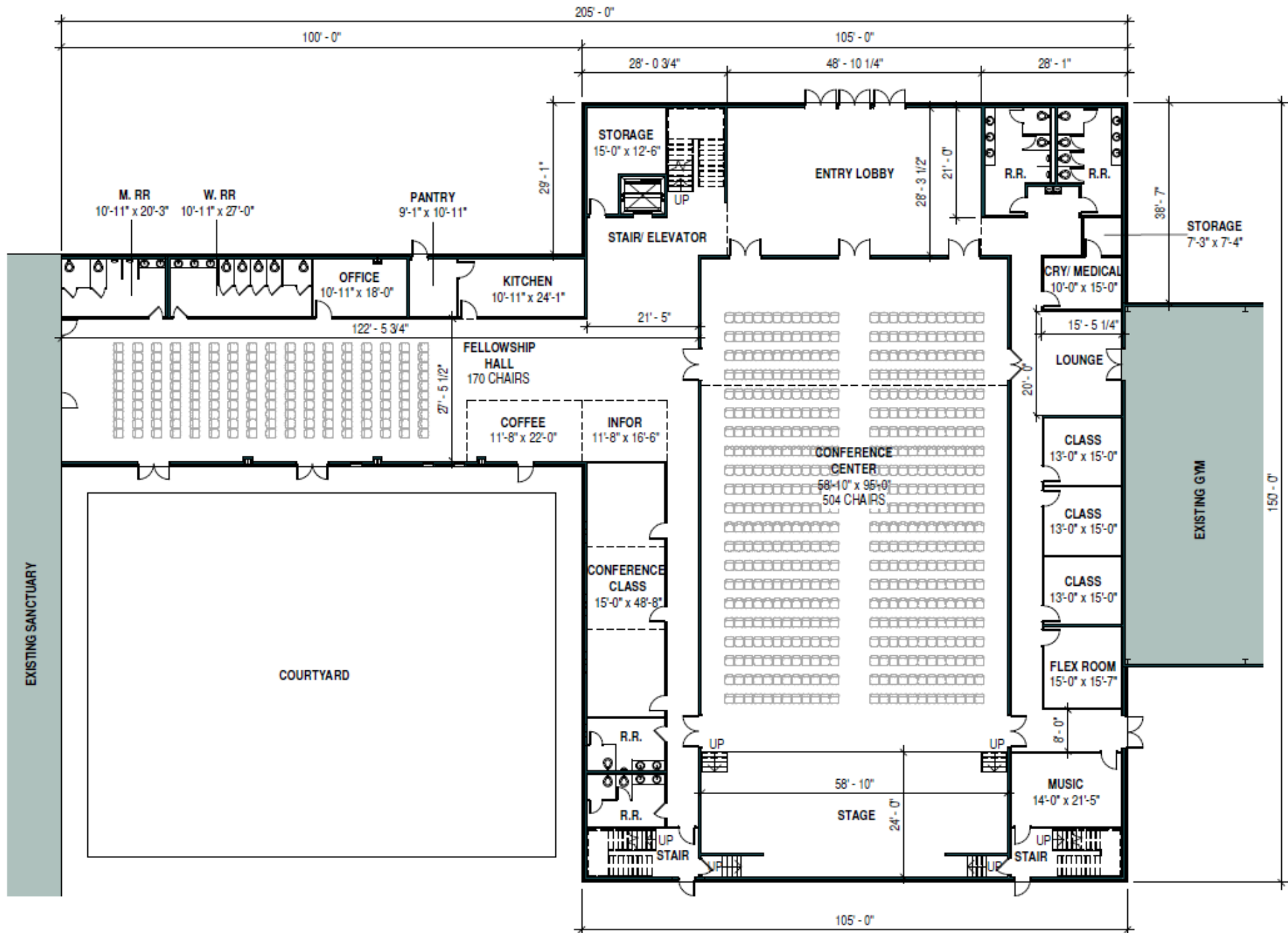

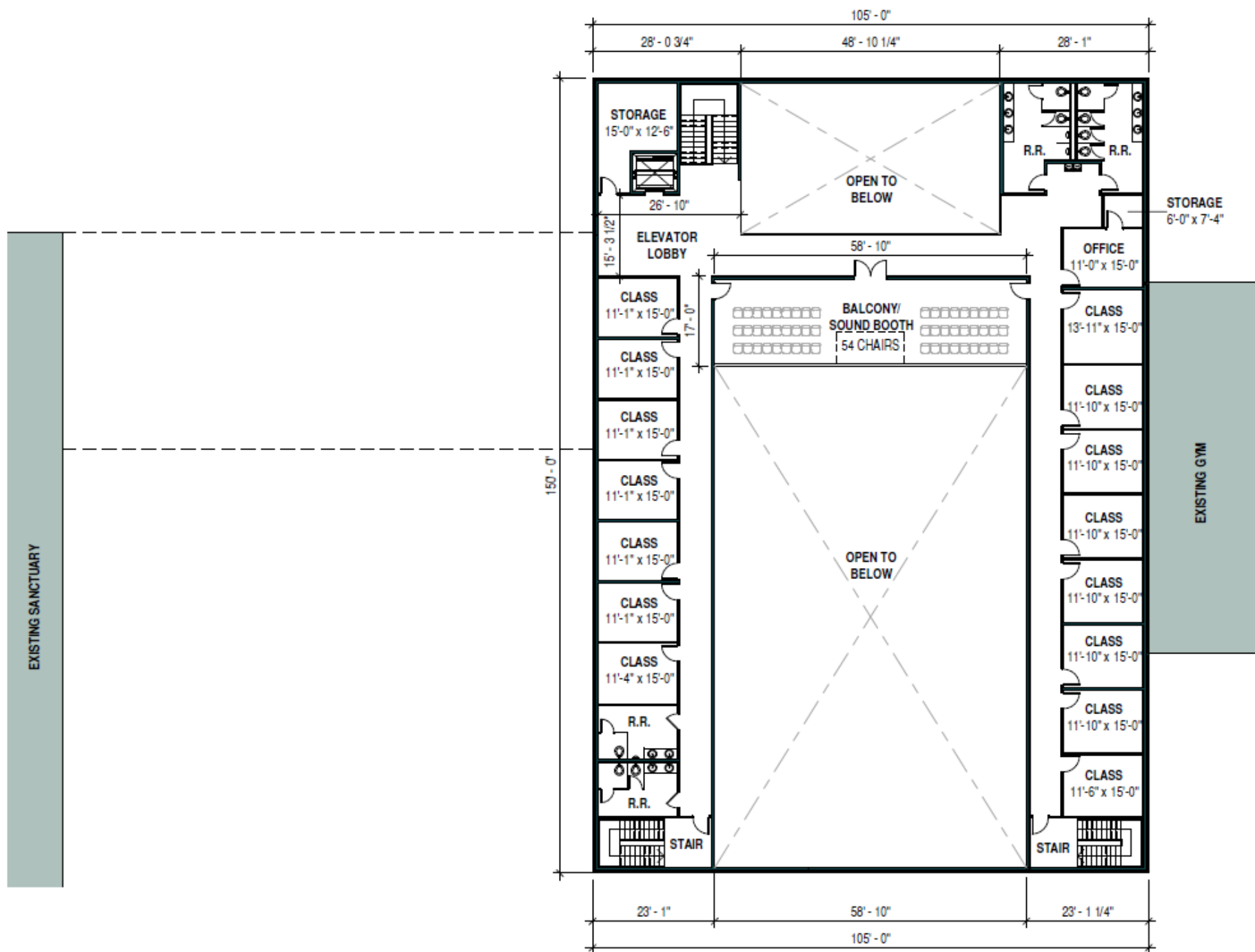
